I started building furniture in my dad's hobby shop when I was 15, but our family venture began in summer 2001. We initially crafted small items for a local distributor and occasionally built kitchens. I continued working a day job until November 2003.

In 2004, we relocated to our current location and began focusing more on kitchens. By 2006, we expanded our work to include fireplaces, and Curveside Wood was founded (although we had been in business since 2001 under a different name).

Over the years, we've occasionally brought in outside help, but we've found that we prefer keeping it a family affair (all four of our children have spent time working in the shop).

In 2016, we expanded the shop, more than doubling the size of our building.

Finally in 2017, we quit making small items for our distributor after reaching 30+ items at peak.

In 2020, after Covid, the handcrafted furniture market exploded leading us to pause kitchen projects until 2024. Custom kitchen cabinetry has always been one of our main goals so we have stayed small intentionally to keep our business family-run. God has blessed us in this endeavor and all honor and glory belong to Him.

As of 2024, we bring 23 years of experience to our craft. We specialize in building wholesale furniture, fireplace cabinets, secretary desks, islands, and wine cabinets for retailers.

We also create custom kitchen cabinets with a highly personalized approach. If the location isn't too far away, I personally visit the jobsite to take measurements. I collaborate with the homeowner and/or contractor to design the cabinets and layout. Every cabinet blueprint is hand-drawn by me. Typically, I have at least one helper in the shop to assist with the building process. Homeowners always receive a copy of the drawings for approval.

Now, let me tell you about our cabinet construction process. We use all domestically sourced (made in the USA) maple plywood for the interiors and cabinet boxes. For the faces, doors, and drawer fronts, you can choose from a variety of hardwoods. Our drawers are crafted from dovetailed maple and feature undermount soft-close slides, along with concealed soft-close hinges. We source our accessories from Century Components and Rev-A-Shelf. I work closely with a trusted small shop to finish all our furnishings. I also handle delivery and installation, and we offer countertops through a company based in Shipshewana, Indiana.
